E-mail is a popular way to communicate your views to your elected official. Tips for transmitting an effective e-mail message are similar to writing a letter, though this format is usually less formal and allows you to be a bit briefer in your message. A major advantage of e-mail versus a personally written letter is the speed in which your message will be received.

Be prepared for some lawmakers to "respond" to your e-mail message with a canned reflector message that may not specifically address your concern.
