

What is Capwiz?

Capwiz is an online advocacy program developed by Capitol Advantage that allows for users to send advocacy messages and alerts to supporters or members in a variety of ways. It also allows for messages to be sent to key legislators at the state and national levels.

From the home page see at a glance:

Find your elected official. From the Home page, click on Elected Officials. Enter your zip code to find your legislators. Click on your legislator's name, then click on the Contact tab. Here you will find the information for the Topeka office and Home office.

Communicate with the Media. Click on Media Guide to select up to five newspapers, radio stations, televisions stations and magazines at a time and send them a message. To learn more about each organization click on the name. Send emails to individuals on staff. Please note that only larger cities are represented here.

Communicate with State Legislators. From the home page click on State Legislature Basics (under Policy Tools). Click on Writing or Phoning Your Reps to better understand the protocol in communicating effectively with members of the Kansas Legislature.

Learn about Current Issues, Key Votes, and Legislative Alerts and Updates. From the home, page, click on Issues at the top of the page. Make your selection from there.
